

## Scholarship Fund

Deadline for Scholarship Application is February 1, 2019

### Requirements

1. Applicants must be one of the following:
  - a. A senior student with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher who is slated for graduation and who has applied and been accepted to attend a college or technical school in any course of study. The student must be graduating from one of the schools in Henry County; Holgate, Liberty Center, Napoleon or Patrick Henry.
  - b. A college or technical school student who previously graduated from one of the schools in Henry County; Holgate, Liberty Center, Napoleon or Patrick Henry. The student must be attending full time in an accredited college or technical school.
  - c. A senior student or college or technical school student who is/was homeschooled, whose family resides in one of the school districts in Henry County; Holgate, Liberty Center, Napoleon or Patrick Henry.
  - d. The student must be 25 years or younger to apply for this scholarship.
2. Complete application form with the following attachments:
  - a. An essay describing your future career plans. Essay should be one page, double spaced.
  - b. A resume that includes community service and activities, school activities, church activities and work experiences.
  - c. A current transcript of grades from high school, college and/or technical school.
  - d. ACT and/or SAT scores.
  - e. A letter of recommendation from an educational, religious or career professional.
  - f. Two adult references (non-family) who may be contacted regarding your application.

### Scholarship Details

1. Scholarships will be awarded to students in the four school districts in Henry County as follows:
  - a. Holgate district residents – two \$2,000.00 Scholarships
  - b. Liberty Center district residents – two \$2,000.00 Scholarships
  - c. Napoleon district residents – two \$2,000.00 Scholarships
  - d. Patrick Henry district residents – two \$2,000.00 Scholarships
2. Scholarship money will be made payable to the bursar office of the college or technical school.
3. Students may re-apply to the scholarship annually until they reach the age of 25 if they are continuing their post high school education. Past winners of the scholarship are not automatically chosen as continued winners upon reapplication.
